- Demonstrate knowledge of the current Movement Analysis/Technical Understanding Assessment Activities.

Learning Experiences

- Share why PSIA should never have ignored Center Line, nor should we dismiss our past because they are the foundation for current and future concepts. Any model on their own doesn't tell the whole story, it's just one chapter.
- Discuss why Center Line and the Common Threads were misunderstood as being too linear in nature and how other concepts (Skills Concept, Lateral Learning, Stepping Stones, Skiing Fundamentals, the Learning Connection Model, etc. are all valuable in supporting an understanding of skiing and teaching that embraces clarity and flexibility.
- Explore how the Center Line milestones will be used as Assessment Activities for the Integrated Fundamentals Assessment Criteria.
- Explore how other Assessment Activities are used for the Individual Fundamentals and Versatility Assessment Criteria.



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- Discuss updates to the Movement Analysis/ Technical Understanding Assessment Activities.
- Review the distinctions between our Cert Prep Clinics and Continuing Education Clinics. Share the Alpine Committee's vision for a future Continuing Education Curriculum.
- Discuss strategies for training certification candidates in how to teach high-quality lessons in the teaching assessments.
